**SUPERSTAR DIANA ROSS
TO PERFORM AT “MONSTER CABLE
RETAILER AWARDS AND CONCERT”
AT CES 2009 IN LAS VEGAS**

With Motown records, Diana Ross and the Supremes had 12 number one hits (1964-70), including "Baby Love" and "Stop! In the Name of Love," and were one of the most successful pop acts of the decade.

Ms. Ross emerged as a solo artist in the '70s with hits such as "Ain't No Mountain High Enough" and "Touch Me in the Morning." During the 80's she continued to top the charts with hits including "Endless Love," "Upside Down" and "Chain Reaction.”

In 2006 she made the jazz charts with her album “Blue.” She recently released “I Love You,” an album of modern standards by the likes of Marvin Gaye, Bill Withers, Harry Nilsson and The Beatles.

Past Monster concerts have featured music greats like Mary J Blige, Stevie Wonder, Rod Stewart, B.B. King, Ray Charles, Crosby, Stills and Nash and James Brown.
